



2010 MVYSA Coach of the Year Nomination Form (Girls and Boys)



Requirements to apply:

An individual may be nominated and selected as the Coach of the Year for extraordinary accomplishments as a coach if the individual –

1. Has coached for at least one seasonal year immediately prior to the seasonal year for which the individual is being nominated;
2. Is coaching during the seasonal year for which the nomination is being made;
3. Has coached and is coaching for a MVYSA organization
4. Is an excellent role model for the community beyond soccer;
5. Has favorable relations with other members of the soccer community;
6. Demonstrates a willingness to promote players and soccer;
7. Is a positive role model for all volunteers;
8. Is of sound moral and ethical character;
9. Through participation, has increased the opportunities for others to participate in soccer;
10. Has not previously received national or other significant recognition from MVYSA or US Youth Soccer for contributions to soccer, but is well known in his or her community and is a true hero of grassroots soccer;
11. The coach can be a volunteer or paid coach;
12. May be nominated for either or both boys or girls COY award, but will only be selected for one COY award for a year.

Criteria:

1) **Sportsmanship:**

Does coach provide example of sportsmanship? Teach to players and supporters? Are players encouraged to comprehend the link between sportsmanship and life? Does the coach practice what he/she preaches?

2) **Player development:**

Are players motivated to learn and play to extent of their ability and capability? Does the coach inculcate enthusiasm, creativity, independence, self-confidence, and risk taking? Are players encouraged to seek higher competition? Does coach encourage players to train on their own or play in "pick-up" games?

3) **Personal coaching development:**

Continues to learn and perfect skills and abilities? Has he/she taken courses in all aspects of game; refereeing, coaching, or playing? Does the coach participate in some manner whether playing or refereeing? Does he/she learn about the game in other ways?

4) **Citizenship:**

Is the coach well known in own soccer community and aware of the larger soccer world? Does the coach positively influence soccer beyond his own team? Is the coach open to suggestions or other ideas?
